Community Legal Education Seminars

CASE for Refugees Inc. provides free community legal education seminars on many areas of law which affect refugee and CaLD communities. The free community legal education seminars cover legal issues such as:

Starting a Business

Legal issues to consider when starting a business: business structures, understanding contracts, employing staff, obtaining finance and other important considerations.

Understanding Contracts

What a Contract is and issues you need to consider before signing a Contract.

Wills, Probate and Intestacy

Why you need a Will and what happens if you die without a Will.

Enduring Powers of Attorney

Why you need an Enduring Power of Attorney to enable another person to handle your affairs when you are unable to.

Anti-Discrimination Laws

What is discrimination, with a focus on racial discrimination, how does the Australian legal system ensure you are being treated fairly and how to make a complaint.

Criminal Injuries Compensation

Victims of Crime may be entitled to claim for compensation. Your rights and how to claim.

Police Powers, Search and Seizure Laws

Issues regarding Police questioning, arrest, and search and property seizure laws.

Driving Laws

Explanation of driving laws including traffic offences, licensing of drivers and motor vehicles, extraordinary driver's licences and driving while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

The free sessions will be presented by CASE for Refugees Inc. staff and Board members with legal expertise. Interpreters can be provided, subject to funding.
